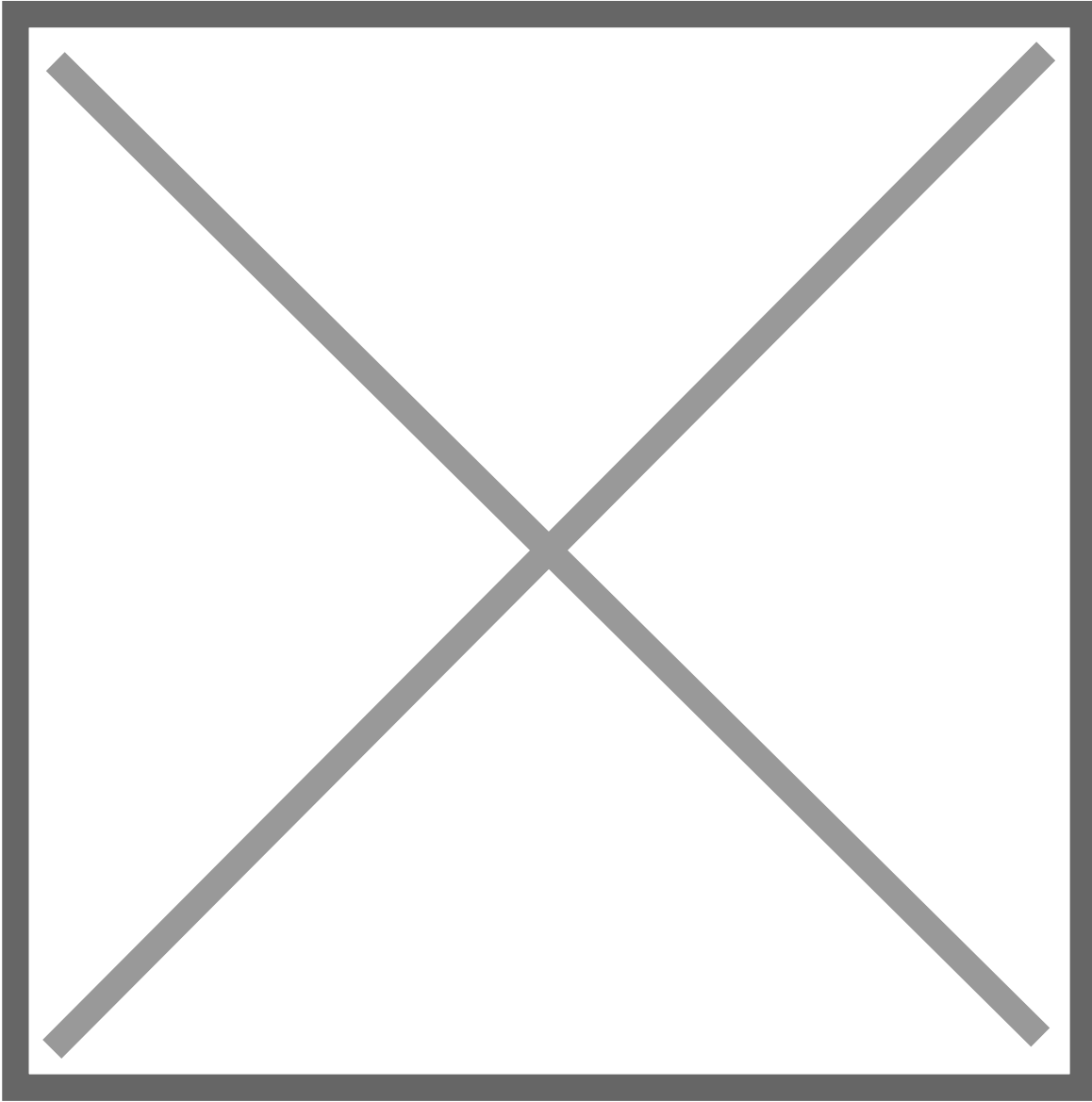


Exemplos | Examples

- Exemplo 1 | Example #1

Paciente masculino, 49 anos, com queixa de dor torácica e palpitações. Tem diagnóstico de hipertensão arterial sistêmica. Ao ECG, apresenta ritmo regular sinusal, com **sobrecarga biventricular**, representada por eixo elétrico de QRS no plano frontal desviado para a direita, associado a critérios de voltagem para SVE; ECG sugestivo de SVD, associado a um ou mais dos seguintes elementos: R de voltagem aumentada em V5 e V6 e S de V1 + R de V5 e V6 com critério positivo de Sokolow.

*A 49-year-old male patient presenting with chest pain and palpitations. He has history of hypertension. The ECG shows regular sinus rhythm with **biventricular enlargement**, indicated by rightward deviation of the QRS electrical axis in the frontal plane. There are also voltage criteria consistent with left ventricular hypertrophy (LVH) and electrocardiographic findings suggestive of right ventricular hypertrophy (RVH). Notable findings include increased voltage R waves in leads V5 and V6, as well as the S wave in V1 along with the R waves in V5 and V6 meeting the positive Sokolow criterion.*



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
